TERMS AND CONDITIONS

VISHENKA Russian-English NURSERY

Any parent who has filled in and submitted the Nursery Place Offer form is presumed to have read and accepted the Terms & Conditions notified below. The acceptance letter, the Terms & Conditions and its annexes (the Financial Policy and the Nursery Rules and Policies available on the nursery's website) are the basis of the legal "contract" between "VISHENKA", private independent bilingual nursery and the Parents.

INTRODUCTION – The parties

- "VISHENKA", private independent bilingual nursery registered by Ofsted under the number EY332671 (premises 1) and URN: 2703367 (premises 2) or "The Nursery"
- Parents/responsible persons who have signed the acceptance letter (cf. article 1), named "the Parents".

ARTICLE 1 - PARENTAL AUTHORITY

If the Parents declare that they have sole legal parental authority, both should submit and sign together the Nursery Place Offer form.

If a Parent/legal responsible adult who has submitted the Nursery Place Offer form declares that he/she has sole legal parental authority under a court order, a copy of the court order must be provided.

The Nursery expects the Parents or responsible persons to communicate with each other and to agree about their child's education. The Nursery will be entitled to accept instructions from either parent without reference to the other. Special dispositions can be put in place in the case of parents who are separated according to any court order provided.

ARTICLE 2 – The SCHOOL RULES and POLICIES

Parents undertake to read and sign the Nursery rules provided at the beginning of the school year.

Compulsory school Policies are available on the school's website.

The Nursery rules and Policies may be updated during the school year; in this case the updated versions are available on the school's website.

We consider that every member of the Nursery should feel valued and respected, and that each person should be treated fairly and well. Bullying, harassment, victimisation, intimidation and



discrimination will not be tolerated. The Nursery's anti bullying policy forms part of these Terms and Conditions. The Nursery applies the Equality Act 2010 and expects the same of the nursery community.

ARTICLE 3 - PROVISION OF EDUCATION

The Nursery undertakes to educate the child during the school year, excluding the school holiday periods, as specified in the school calendar published at the beginning of each school year. It is the Parents' responsibility to accompany their child to nursery and also to collect him/ her.

ARTICLE 4 – APPLICATION PROCESS

4 – 1 FIRST APPLICATION

Stage 1: Pre-application

A) Nursery Welcome Pack

Parents are requested to review our comprehensive nursery welcome pack. This pack contains essential information, including details on fees, policies, and terms and conditions, ensuring a smooth transition for a child into our nurturing environment.

B) Make an appointment

To visit the nursery, you need to make an appointment:

C) Admission commissions

Place offer criteria and priority:

- children with a sibling already attending one of our schools, are offered places in priority

Stage 2: Place offer

The offer consists of an online Nursery Place Offer form and an Application Form and is exclusively made by email. Parents are thus requested to return these two documents duly completed and signed by email within the given deadline.

Stage 3: Registration



The application is final when the formalities detailed below have been completed (in due time):

Step 1: Documents

- o The School Place Offer form has to be completed, signed and returned (parents are required to read the Terms and Conditions attached to the place offer email)
- o Application form has to be completed, signed and returned by email and a printout to the nursery.
- o Medical form, authorisation to collect form, authorisation to transfer form and photo consent form need to be completed and returned by email and as a printout to the nursery.
- o Copies of both Parents/ legal responsible adults' passports have to be sent.
- o Copy of the child's passport has to be sent
- o In the case of a divorce/ separation: copy of the court order settling the custody arrangements has to be provided; a letter co-signed by both parents and detailing their common custody arrangement is required if no court order has been taken

Step 2: Payments

- o Payment of £250 annual non-refundable registration fee
- o Payment of £600 advance for the 1st term a child starting the nursery
- o Payment of £600 refundable deposit for the last term (In order to terminate the contract and leave the nursery parents need to give 1 term notice in writing, otherwise, £600 deposit won't be refunded).

Leaving Date start of Autumn Term: Notice must be given prior to 1st week of Summer Term

Leaving Date start of Spring Term: Notice must be given prior to 1st week of Autumn Term

Leaving Date start of Summer Term: Notice must be given prior to 1st week of Spring Term).

NB: If parents wish to cancel the application at any time during the process, these payments remain not refundable. Whatever the motive for cancellation, paid fees are not transferable for a later intake. Parents wishing to re-apply at a later date, will have to start the whole administrative and financial process again.

The Nursery has a right to make enquiries of the child's previous schools for confirmation that all sums due and owing to such schools have been paid.



The Nursery has a right to inform any other school to which the child is to be transferred if any fees of Vishenka are unpaid. A Nursery registration termination certificate will be issued only if all fees due have been paid. In addition, parents consent to provide the Nursery with their child school report of the previous school before the intake of their child.

4-2 RE-ENROLMENT

Process

The child's re-enrolment in our nursery for the following school year is valid when Parents have followed the steps below in due time:

- Notification of the child's Re-enrolment by email.
- Payment of £250 annual registration fee

NB: if parents fail to complete one or the other step, the child is automatically withdrawn from the school's register. The £600 advance is not refundable even if Parents may later choose to withdraw their child. £600 deposit for the last term stays in the nursery if 1 term notice was not given in writing.

Conditions of admission

In order to be offered a place for their child in our nursery:

- Parents have to complete the whole pre-application and application process in full and in due time. Any missing document or payment will incur a cancellation of the application in our files.
- Pupils are enrolled based on their year of birth. (NB: Child has to be two full years old on the 1st day of his/her intake. Younger children may be also enrolled (subject to certain conditions).
- Vishenka will offer a nursery place depending on the availability in the group on the date of the child's intake.
- Priority will be given to a child who already has a sibling registered in our nursery.
- In the case of multiple applications in a year group, priority will be given to the older child.
- If parents are applying for a child with special needs—whether related to learning, physical abilities, or health issues—we kindly request that they engage in direct communication with the Proprietor and Manager. Together, we will determine the appropriate framework within which Vishenka can welcome the child, ensuring their progress and safety. Privately, we will



discuss the school's ability to provide support and any potential barriers. The final nursery placement offer will be contingent upon mutual agreement regarding the proposed framework.

- As detailed in the Terms & Conditions, any withholding or misrepresentation of information or facts about the family or the child is considered as a breach of contract which the Nursery will terminate consequently keeping any paid sum.

ARTICLE 5 - 1st ENROLMENT FEES

- The registration fee of £250 (annual) and £600 advance for the 1st term a child starting the nursery. These payments are not refundable if the Parents later decide to withdraw their child whatever the reason for cancellation.
- £600 deposit for the last term. If contract is terminated in the middle of the term, £600 deposit stays in the school if 1 term notice was not given in writing.

ARTICLE 6 - SCHOOL FEES

For financial purpose, the school year is divided into three periods called terms, detailed as follows:

Autumn Term (September/October/November/December) – Term 1;
Spring Term (January, February, March/April) – Term 2;
Summer Term (April, May, June, July) – Term 3.

Fees are payable at the first two weeks of the beginning of each term as stated in the calendar. The Nursery reserves the right to refuse to admit a child if fees have not been paid, even in the middle of the school year.

Parents are made aware of nursery fees for the next year at the end of the previous year.

There is a 10% discount for the second child. This discount is only applied to nursery fees but not applied to any other fees such after-school care or breakfast club.

We operate different pricing for under 2s. Childcare service for children under two is more expensive because of higher staff ratios. We will give you detailed pricing information once you have selected your preferred days.

Fees for any started term will not be refunded and remain retained by the nursery.

In the case of parents' decision to change nursery in the middle of the term, the fee for the current term remains due to the school.



Tuition fees will be payable in full for intakes occurring within the 1st period of each term (nursery calendar available on the nursery's website). For intakes occurring after the 1st period, tuition fees are calculated pro rata the attendance of the child.

The Financial Policy is fully part of the Terms & Conditions.

ARTICLE 7 – ATTENDANCE

Parents are required to obtain written consent from Vishenka for any planned absences: Vishenka manager or Nursery Director will grant the authorisation for absence or not. **If a child is away for more than two weeks a 50% of the fee is payable to reserve a place.** Funded children should have a valid reason for absence.

If a child hasn't attended a large volume of the claimed universal credit hours without a valid evidence, a full-term fee is payable.

No leave of absence will be granted when Parents take their child on holiday in term time.

Fees for a term will not be refunded where the child is absent due to sickness or for any other reasons.

Session Times: We offer either morning sessions until 12 PM or full-day sessions until 4 PM. Unfortunately, we do not provide any sessions in between these times.

Children are not allowed to attend nursery on alternate days to make up for the days they were absent. They can ask for extra days paid separately if agreed with the manager.

ARTICLE 8 - TERMINATION

When a child reaches four years of age and becomes eligible for reception, their time at our nursery ends automatically. Parents will receive a £600 deposit refund as part of this transition. No extra notice is needed in this case.

However, if parents choose to withdraw their child before the standard transition to reception, we kindly ask for at least one term's notice. This ensures a seamless adjustment and maintains fairness in our refund process

If Parents withdraw their child during the course of a term, Vishenka has to be notified in writing, giving details of the next school the child will attend. The Nursery will invoice the fees for the whole term.

The Nursery may terminate the contract at any time by notice in writing without any obligation to return any fees or deposit paid by parents in the case the Parents find themselves in breach of the Terms & Conditions and/or any of the Nursery Rules.



Any withholding or misrepresentation of information or facts about the family or the child is considered as a breach of contract which Vishenka will terminate consequently keeping any paid sum.

ARTICLE 9 - ACTIVITIES DURING THE HOLIDAYS

During school holidays, the Nursery may organize specific activities. Parents will engage in a formal agreement regarding these activities, with the understanding that corresponding fees are due in full and in advance.

Parents and guardians will be required to review and sign the nursery's Terms and Conditions at the beginning of each academic year.

1. **Opening Hours:**

- Our doors open promptly at **8:55 a.m.** (except during breakfast club hours).
- The morning session finishes at **12:00 p.m.**
- The afternoon session ends at **4:00 p.m.**

2. **Garden Gate Etiquette:**

- Always close one gate before opening the other to maintain safety.
- Consider the well-being of all children, not just your own.

3. **Late Collection:**

- If you anticipate being late to collect your child at **12:00 p.m.**, please inform us.
- In the absence of communication, we will take your child to our second building.
- Notify us in writing of any changes related to collection arrangements.
- In emergencies, when an unfamiliar person collects your child, provide a letter with their name, date of birth, and a photograph.

4. **Sickness Protocol:**

- If your child is unwell, promptly inform us and describe the symptoms.
- This helps us assess whether the illness is contagious.
- Please ensure your child arrives clean in the morning (nappy-wise).

5. **Cleanliness and Potty Training:**

- If your child has an “accident” in the car, feel free to use our facilities for changing.
- Regarding potty training:
 - We follow a toilet routine before and after snack times, before playground activities, and before a child goes home.
 - Consistency between home and nursery routines is essential.
 - If your child wears pull-ups but is prone to “accidents”, provide spare nappies to avoid complete undressing during changes.
 - Avoid dressing your child in one-piece outfits (bodies), belts, or dungarees, as they hinder toilet use.
 - Remember that stressors (such as starting nursery, having a new sibling, or moving) may temporarily affect potty training progress.

6. **Clothing:**

- Our nursery has no uniform; we encourage self-expression through clothing.
- Dress your child comfortably to participate fully in activities.
- Please label all items, especially hats, scarves, gloves, and backpacks.
- Return any clothing we provide during changes.
- During rainy weather, bring your child in boots—outdoor play in all conditions is valuable, and spare indoor shoes are welcome.
